## **Meeting Minutes**

- 1. Meeting called to order at 12:35
- 2. In attendance: Cindy Brady, Kelly Close, Steve Lundt, Al Polonski, Paul Tedesco; by phone: Andy Cross, Mike Eytel, Craig Wolf
- 3. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes (August 16, 2016)
  - a. Mike moved to approve the minutes as drafted
  - b. Kelly seconded the motion
  - c. Motion passed
- 4. Agenda Additions and Deletions
  - a. None
- 5. Treasurer's Report Laurie
  - a. Waddell & Reed account: \$16,549.40
  - b. Checking account: \$21,021.14
  - c. 2016 income to date: \$5,290.00
  - d. 2016 withdrawals to date: \$4371.37
  - e. Cindy reports that Day on the Rez essentially broke even
- 6. Committee Reports
  - a. Membership Steve
    - Joint CLRMA/NALMS memberships for 2017 (Cindy and/or Mike)
      - Mike has spoken to NALMS about this and reports that it has been explored in the past but no similar arrangements have ever been made
        - Mike will try and push something through at the NALMS business meeting in Banff
        - Steve has some thoughts for Mike and will send those along by email
        - Anyone else with thoughts on the matter please talk to Mike before the NALMS 2016 Annual Conference
    - Steve thought that when we send out renewal notices in December it might be smart to also use the opportunity to call for papers and sponsorships
      - Usually these renewal notices go only to current members. This
        year we could have a wider mailing to include former members as
        well
  - b. Conferences / Workshops

- NALMS Symposium 2017 Steve-
  - 1. November 6<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> Westminster Westin
  - 2. Sponsorship
    - □ Is CLRMA willing to be a sponsor of the conference?
      - i. CLRMA is guaranteed \$5000 as part of the usual agreement between the local chapter and NALMS
      - ii. Often, local chapters donate these funds back to the conference committee
      - iii. CLRMA should have little to no conference related expenses as long as we have expenses approved through NALMS and submitted to them directly
      - iv. For every local sponsor or exhibiter that is not a usual participant in NALMS conferences, CLRMA gets a portion of those funds
      - v. Board is amenable to sponsoring the event but will table the matter for now
    - Westminster is considering sponsoring at the \$4000 level
    - □ Historically, \$30,000 was a typical fund raising goal for host committees. With reduced federal spending on conferences such as this, similar fundraising goals may be optimistic

    - Andy has confirmed our reservation
  - 3. Lunch
    - Kelly Close will handle
    - Al will bring donuts and coffee in the morning
    - Plan on roughly 50 people in attendance
  - 4. Awards
    - Al, Mike, Steve and Andy have all agreed to help with awards
      - i. CLRMA Board generally does not participate in this process, however, anyone and everyone is encouraged to nominate deserving individuals
    - □ \$200 allotted for gifts
      - A plaque is generally included with the Secchi disc award
        - Plaque is paid for with these funds
        - The rest of the awards are printed on card stock

    - Al has a presentation regarding nutrient sampling at Summit Lake
    - Steve can give a presentation about carp removal at Barr Lake
    - Cindy could give a talk about Denver Water's efforts to improve fishing/fisheries downstream of some if it's facilities

      - ii. Tourism/promotional materials also should be made available

    - There have been no other interested individuals among our membership
    - Board agrees to give the registration to Mike
